


The *INHS Bulletin* is one of the oldest scientific publications in North America, having been published continuously since 1876, and has a worldwide distribution. The *INHS Bulletin* publishes monographs, research papers, and conceptual reviews on all aspects of biology, ecology, and the natural sciences. We welcome manuscripts from all biomes, taxa, disciplines, and cultures, as well as all research approaches, including experimental, theoretical, and analytical, as well as the development of new methodologies.

The *INHS Bulletin* transitioned to being an open-access publication in 2019. Being open-access allows the *INHS Bulletin* to meet our goal of wide-dissemination of the research in our journal, among other benefits. Our current article processing charges (APC) are \$295 (with an additional fee for manuscripts of more than 20 typeset pages). Historically, the *INHS Bulletin* focused on significant research findings by Illinois Natural History Survey scientists, but has transitioned to welcome research from all scientists. All submitted papers must be original research and not previously published.
