- (1) Program numbers and revision levels are provided for only operational programs which have flown or are expected to be flown. Program numbers and revision levels apply to memory loader tapes through MF-6, and to the "A" section of the LVUT (AGE) tape on MF-7 modules.
- (2) Start date corresponds to the initiation of work on the original math flow, and not to the particular revision level flown. Work on the revision levels always started at a date later than shown.

- (3) System math flow release date corresponds to the initial release of the document, and not to the System math flow revision level which corresponds to the program number revision level.
- (4) Sell off date corresponds to the date the particular program number and level were sold off at IBM, and not to the original unrevised program.
