(2) 12 UK military export licences for Israel since 2010, with categories ML4 (Bombs, torpedoes, rockets, missiles, other explosive devices and charges, and related equipment and accessories), ML11a (Electronic equipment for military use), ML14 (Specialised equipment for military training or for simulating military scenarios), ML22a (other technology)

- (3) World's 7th largest arms company. Supplies components for F-15 and F-16 jets and Apache AH-64 helicopters used to attack Gaza, F-35 jets, artillery, drones...

AH-64 Apache helicopters, F-15 fighter jets, Hellfire missiles (produced with Lockheed Martin), MK-84 2000-lb bombs, MK-82 500-lb bombs, Joint Direct Attack Munitions (JDAM) kits that turn bombs into "smart" GPS-equipped guided bombs. Boeing's Harpoon sea-to-sea missile system is installed on the upgraded 4.5 Sa'ar missile ships of the Israeli Navy.

A joint venture with Lockheed Martin, it consists of the Longbow Hellfire missile (AGM-114L) and a fire-control radar (AN/APG-78). Also produces key parts for the F-35, a fighter jet manufactured by Lockheed Martin that Israel acquired through the US Foreign Military Sales program. Northrop Grumman produces approximately 35% of the Lockheed Martin F-35 aircraft
- (17) 8 UK military export licences for Israel, with categories ML4 (explosives), ML11 (electronics), ML15b (imaging), ML22a (other technology). Part of Watchkeeper team lead by Israeli drone firm Elbit and Thales to supply UK MoD.
- (18) World's 2<sup>nd</sup> largest arms firm, supplies guided missiles used to attack Gaza, "bunker buster" bombs, and anti-missile defense.
