

# On International Women's Day Defend The Gaza Women Journalists and Women Of Palestine

The Palestinian Journalists Syndicate in collaboration with the International Federation of Journalists is calling for an international day of action for the women journalists and women of Gaza.

Sixteen women journalists in Gaza have been murdered by the IDF since October 7. Many of their children and family members have also been killed. In the West Bank, journalists including Palestinian American Shireen Abu Akleh have been targeted and murdered. The US government has refused to have an investigation for these war crimes, and the Israeli government and IDF continue these murders with impunity. These sister journalists and all Palestinian journalists are putting their lives in danger to get the story out and break the information blockade. Additionally, there are many Palestinian journalists who have been imprisoned under administrative detention. Some have been jailed for more than 20 years.
