Eligibility and Timeline Notice: To grant credit the following criteria is reviewed: 1) You provided a test scores for the appropriate score threshold and exam, 2) You are not currently enrolled in the requested course, 3) You have not previously taken/passed the requested course, 4) You have established an AC transcript by taking at least one AC undergraduate course credit. If you do not initially meet conditions #1-#4, we will hold the paperwork for up to a 1-year period and will periodically check on your credit eligibility status.

Transfer and Financial Aid Notice: Petitions for credit can be an easy way to honor your hard work and decrease your time to degree. However, it is possible that granted credit may not transfer to your intended four-year university and/or apply to your future degree plan. It's also possible that unneeded, excess credit, may adversely affect your financial aid status or your ability to qualify for the College for All Texans Tuition Rebate. It is the student's responsibility to confirm course transfer eligibility prior to submitting the petition. Once the credit is applied, it will not be removed. For questions related to credit transfer eligibility, please speak with your intended 4-year university transfer credit advising staff or your AC advisor.

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
