If you do not initially meet conditions #1-#4, we will hold the paperwork for up to a 1-year period and will periodically check on your credit eligibility status.

Transfer and Financial Aid Notice: Petitions for credit can be an easy way to honor your hard work and decrease your time to degree. However, it is possible that granted credit may not transfer to your intended four-year university and/or apply to your future degree plan.
