**17 February 2014 – Updates since the 12 February 2014 launch of [BiodiversityMapping.org](http://BiodiversityMapping.org)**

GeoTIFF files for birds have been updated to correct a small problem with multiple background values. This was not an issue with the data in the Map Package, only in the exported GeoTIFF files.

The original 50km resolution maps for the mammal orders Cetartiodactyla, Carnivora, Primates, Eulipotyphla, Chiroptera, and Rodentia were replaced with 10km resolution versions.

New mammal map was added for marsupials (orders Dasyuromorphia, Didelphimorphia, Diprotodontia, Microbiotheria, Notoryctemorphia, Peramelemorphia, and Paucituberculata).

Small revisions to introductory text, acknowledgements, and permissions for use.

Map Package updated to include new maps and updates to methods and permissions in the metadata.

Small changes behind the scenes to improve website performance.
