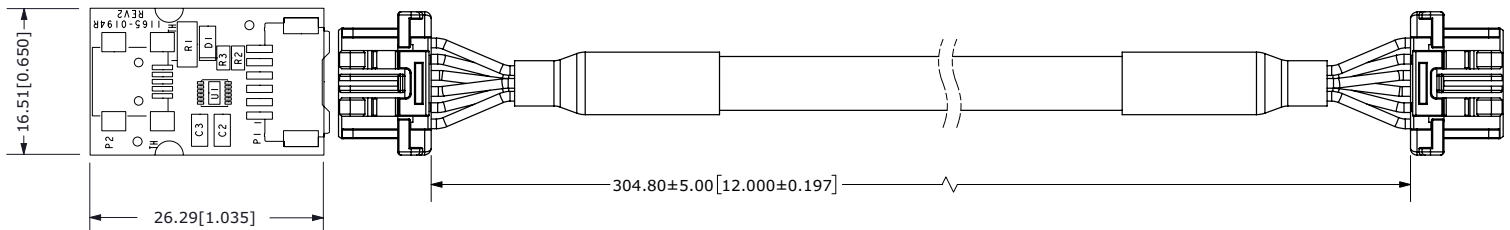

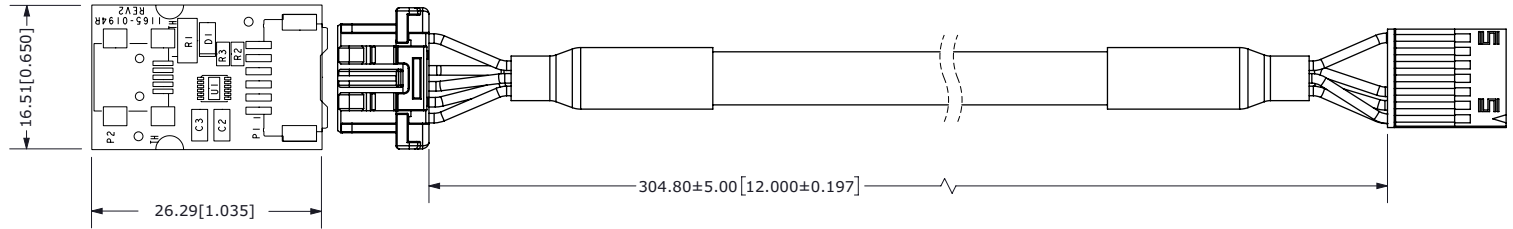
MECHANICAL DRAWING (AMT-PGRM-06C)

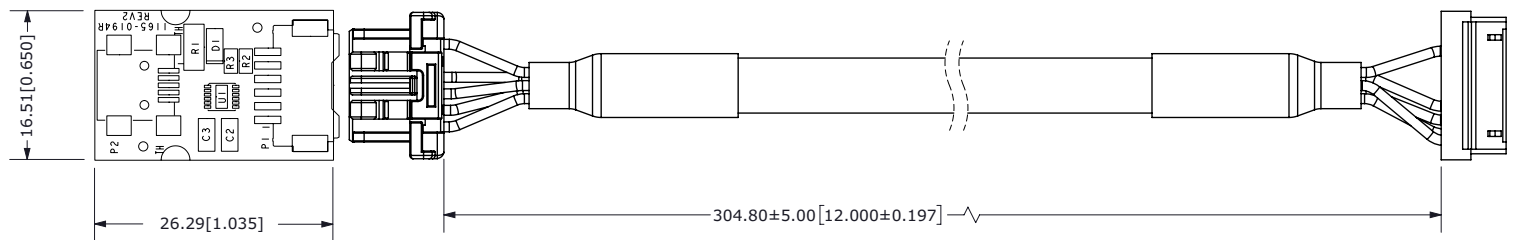
MECHANICAL DRAWING (AMT-PGRM-14C)

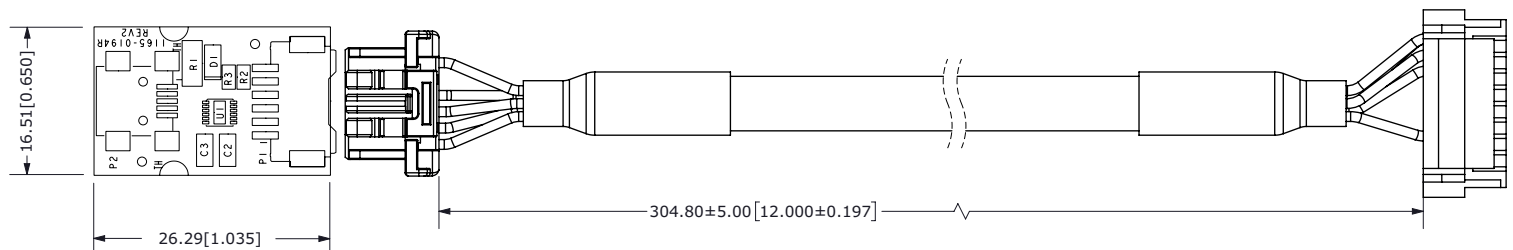
MECHANICAL DRAWING (AMT-PGRM-17C)
