SWAT4LS is an international conference that serves as a venue to present high-quality research from all fields of Semantic Data Science and Web technologies in Health Care and Life Sciences.

The objectives of the SWAT4LS conference are to provide a forum dedicated to the dissemination of original research, discussion of practical insights, and the reporting of experiences relating to the adoption of Semantic technologies applied in biomedical informatics and computational biology. The conference also offers a forum to exchange emerging and thought-provoking ideas through poster and demo presentations.

SWAT4LS 2018 was held at Elzenveld, a historic building that has previously served as hospital and monastery, on December 3-6, 2018, Antwerp, Belgium.

The SWAT4LS 2018 organizers wish to thank the program committee for giving their time and sharing their expertise. Their rigorous evaluations, constructive criticisms and attention to detail helped us arrive at a high-quality program. We thank all researchers that responded to the call for papers by submitting manuscripts for evaluation.
