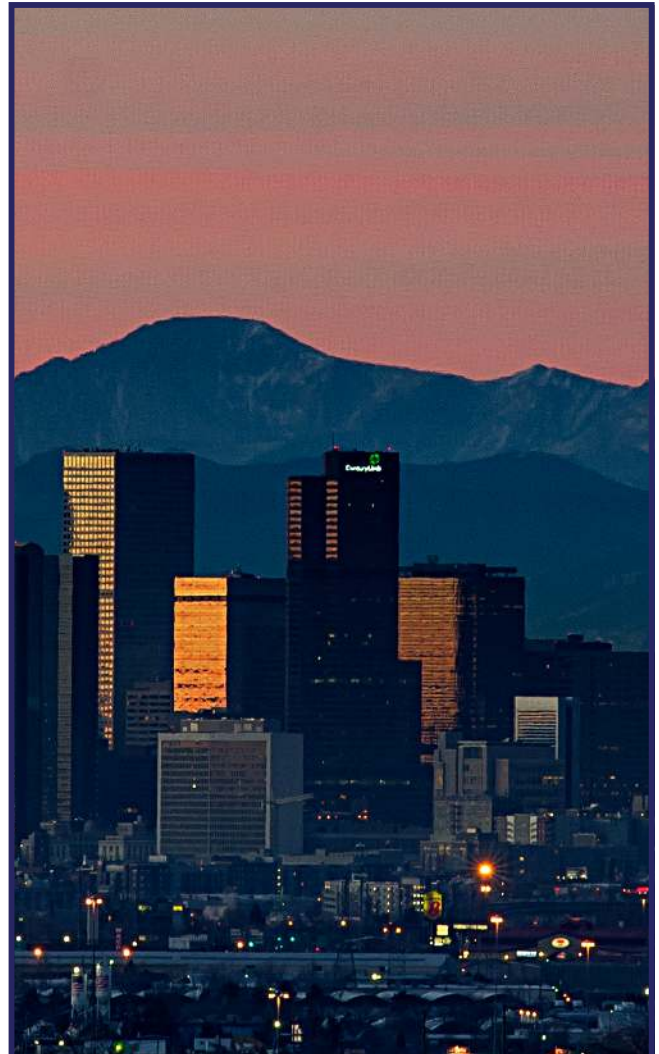

COMMUNITY OVER CODE

Community Over Code, formerly ApacheCon, is the official global conference series of The Apache Software Foundation (ASF). Since 1998 – before the ASF’s incorporation – Community Over Code, and ApacheCon before it, have been drawing participants at all levels to explore “Tomorrow’s Technology Today” across 300+ ASF projects and their diverse communities. Community Over Code showcases the latest developments in ASF projects and emerging innovations through hands-on sessions, keynotes, real-world case studies, trainings, hackathons, and more.

Community Over Code showcases the latest breakthroughs from ubiquitous ASF projects and upcoming innovations in the Apache Incubator, as well as open source development and leading community-driven projects the Apache way. Attendees learn about core open source technologies independent of business interests, corporate biases, or sales pitches.

The Community Over Code program is dynamic, evolving at each event with content directly driven by select Apache Project developer and user communities. Community Over Code delivers state-of-the-art content that features the latest open source advances in big data, cloud, community development, FinTech, IoT, machine learning, messaging, programming, search, security, servers, streaming, web frameworks, and more in a collaborative, vendor-neutral environment.



ABOUT THE ASF: Founded in 1999, the Apache Software Foundation exists to provide software for the public good with support from more than 70 sponsors. ASF’s open source software is used ubiquitously around the world with more than 8,400 committers contributing to 320+ active projects, including Apache Superset, Apache Camel, Apache Flink, Apache HTTP Server, Apache Kafka, and Apache Airflow. The Foundation’s open source projects and community practices are considered industry standards, including the widely adopted Apache License 2.0, the podling incubation process, and a consensus-driven decision model that enables projects to build strong communities and thrive.
