- Visual modeling languages and UML
- Visual programming languages
- Software visualization

All papers accepted by the conference will be published by the ACM Press and included in the ACM Digital Library. Selected research papers of outstanding quality will be considered for publication in the International Journal of Advanced Intelligence and International Journal of Software and Informatics.
