## Origins

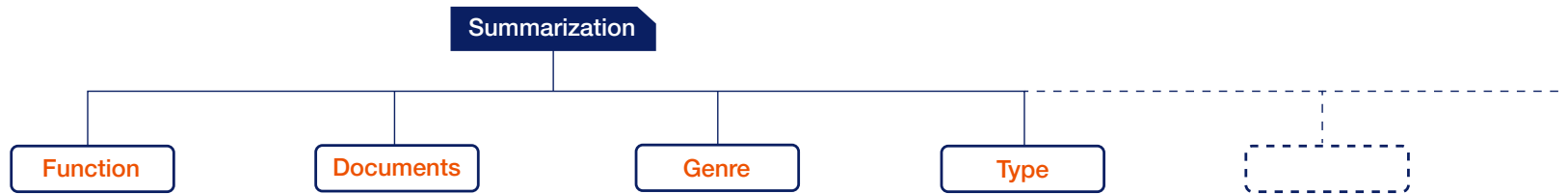
- *summa* → summary
- One of the oldest tasks performed by humans as part of discourse
- Polytypic – abstract, precis, epitome, abridgment, review, digest, minutes

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## Facets of summarization

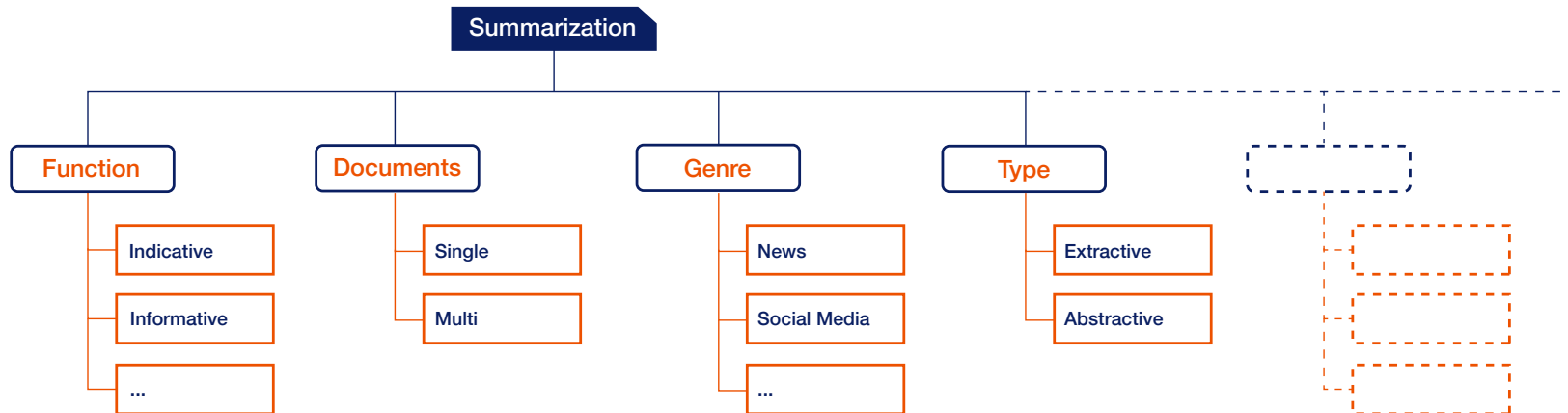


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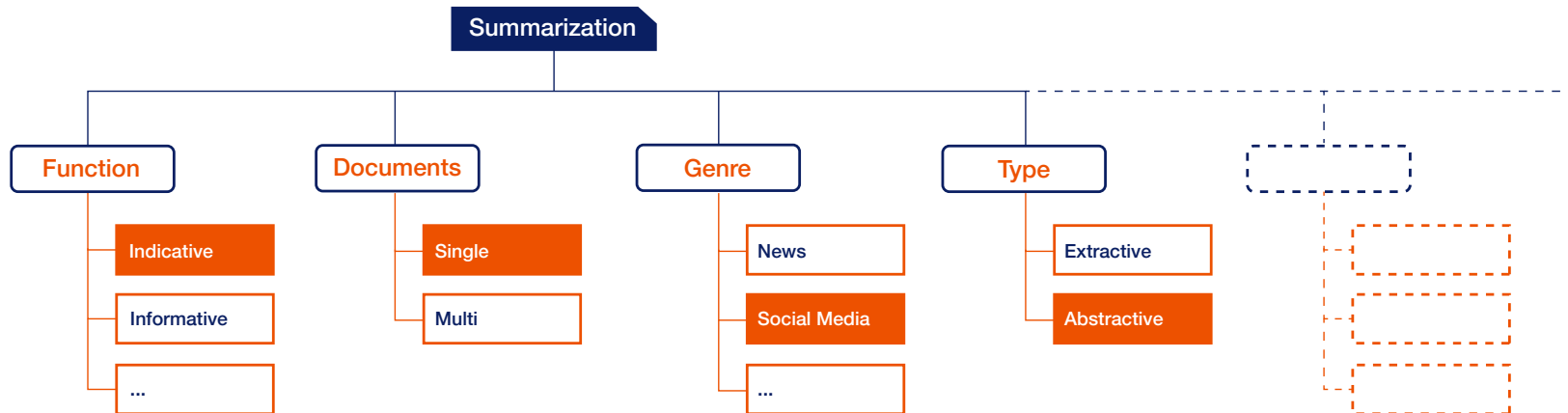

## News articles:

- ❑ Well-defined structure
- ❑ Coherent
- ❑ Proof read
- ❑ Headlines are relatively extractive

## User-generated content:

- ❑ Casual structure
- ❑ Slang
- ❑ Poor grammar
- ❑ Higher level of abstraction

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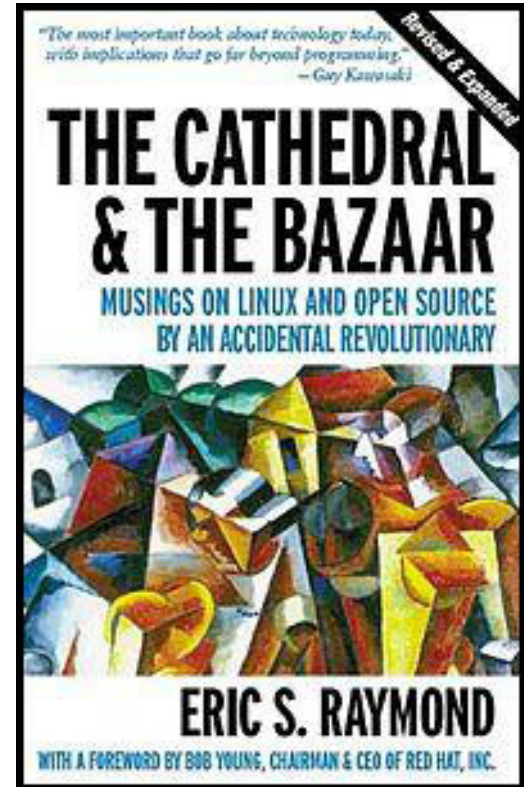

## CNN-DM

(CNN) – NASA will launch Space Shuttle Endeavour on February 7, which will be the first of five launches this year before the shuttle fleet is retired. Endeavour will blast off from the Kennedy Space Center in Florida on a 13-day mission to the international space station. The mission will include three spacewalks, NASA said. The shuttle will also deliver the final U.S. portion of the space station. This portion will provide more room for crew members. NASA plans to retire its space shuttles Discovery, Endeavour and Atlantis later this year. The space agency has been looking for places, such as museums, to house the shuttles after they are retired. Space Shuttle Discovery will be transferred to the Smithsonian National Air and Space Museum in Washington. The privilege of showing off a shuttle won't be cheap – about \$29 million, NASA said.

## Evaluation as a service

- ❑ Reproducibility
- ❑ User control
- ❑ Blind evaluation

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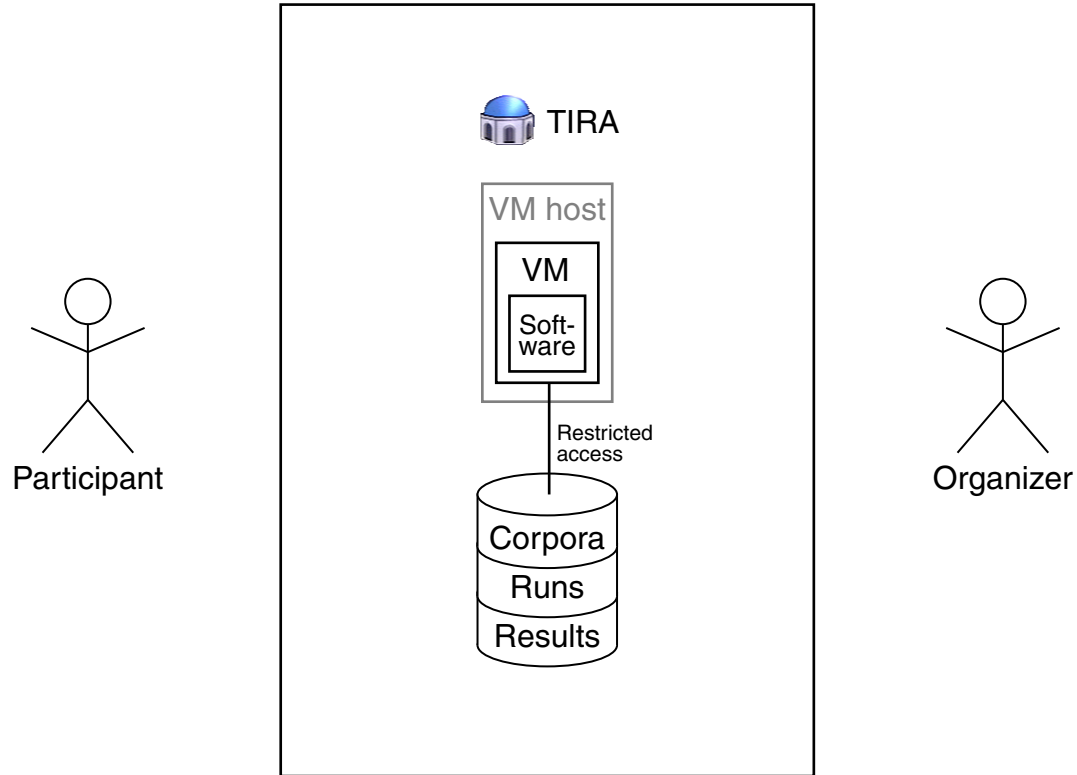
## The TIRA way

- Reproducibility → virtualization for safe & diverse software submissions
- User control → UI to self-monitor & control evaluation runs
- Blind evaluation → sandboxing to avoid test data leakage



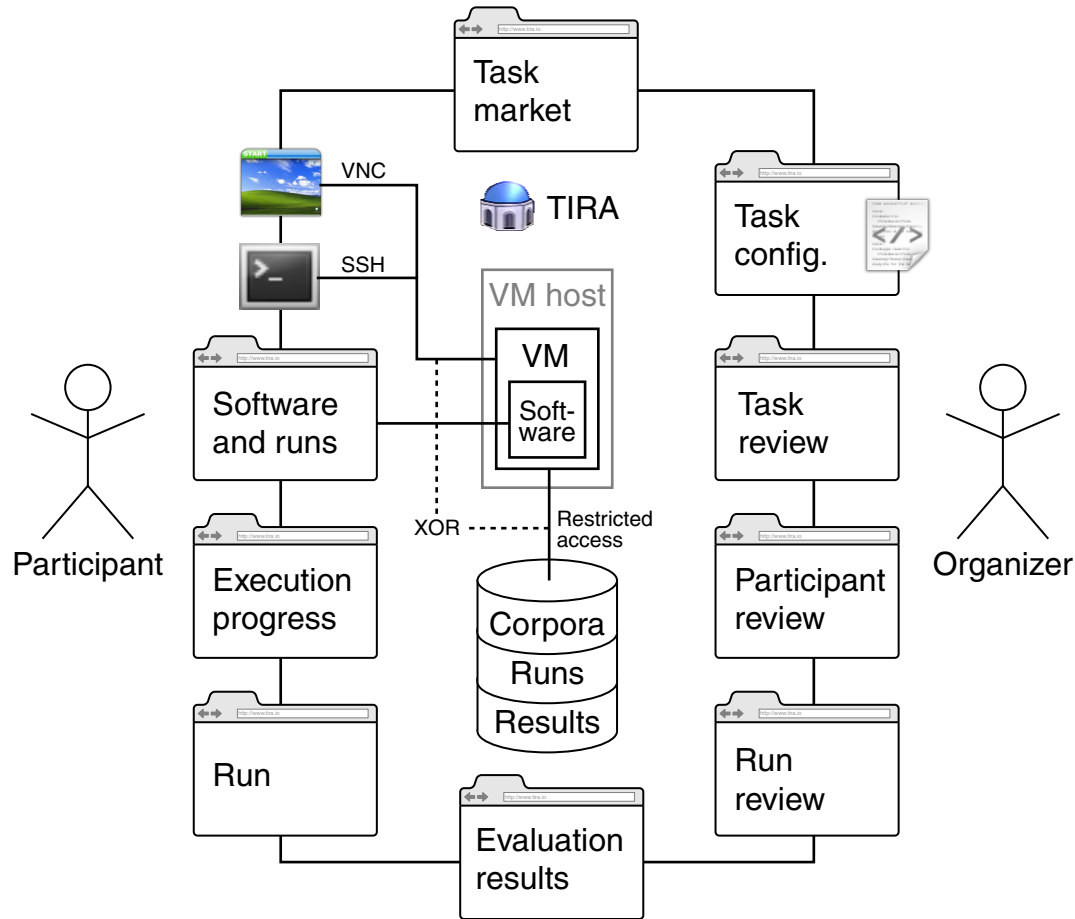
# The TIRA experiment platform

## System Architecture: User Interfaces

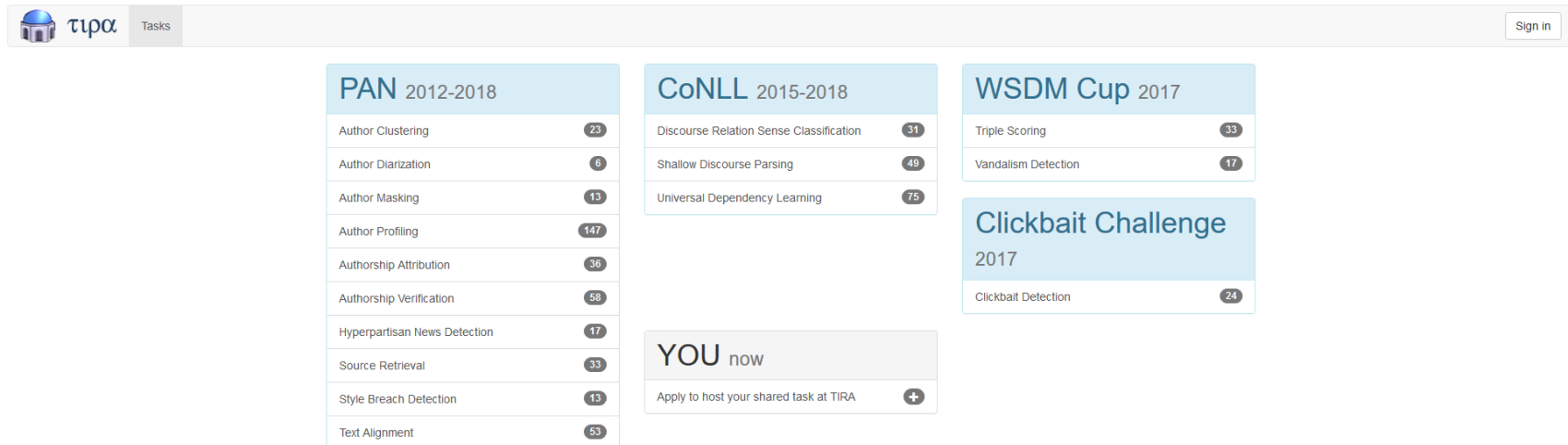


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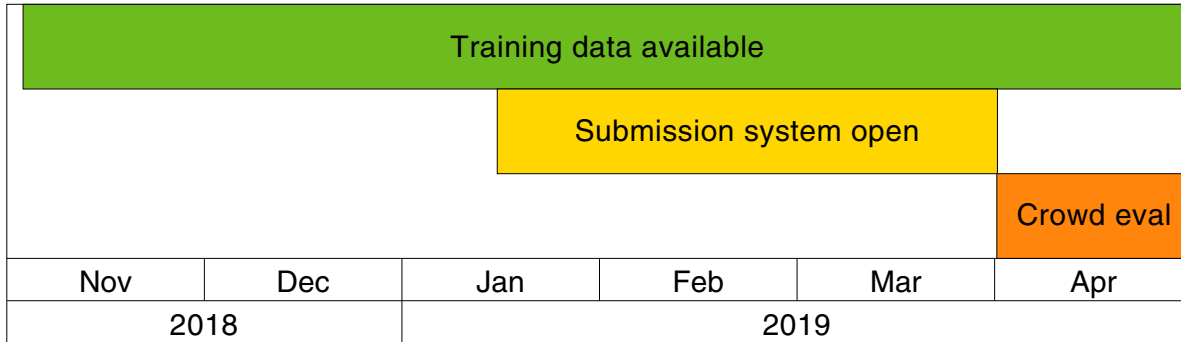
# TIRA adoption

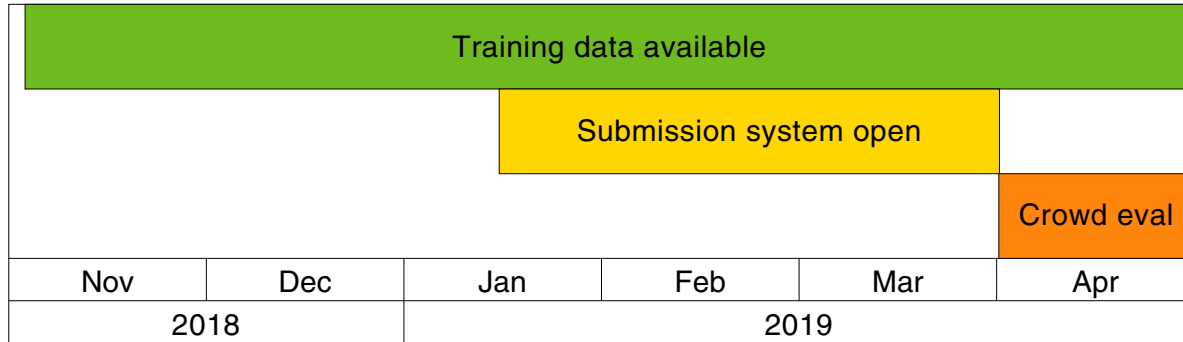
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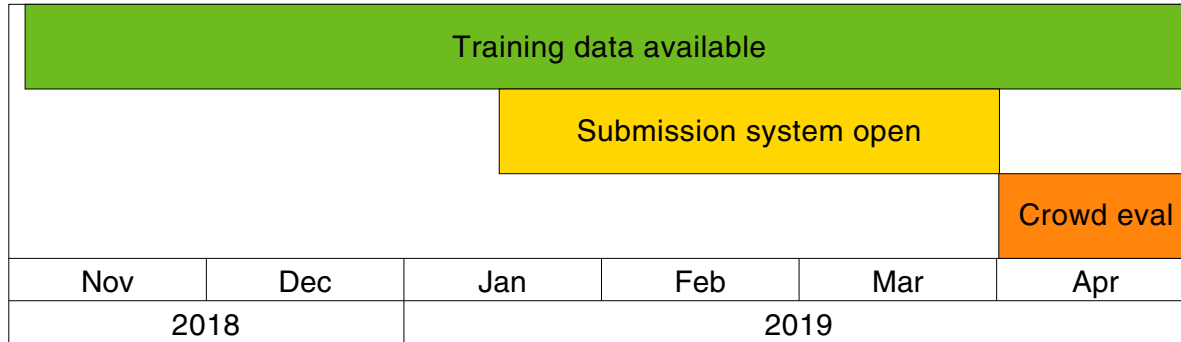

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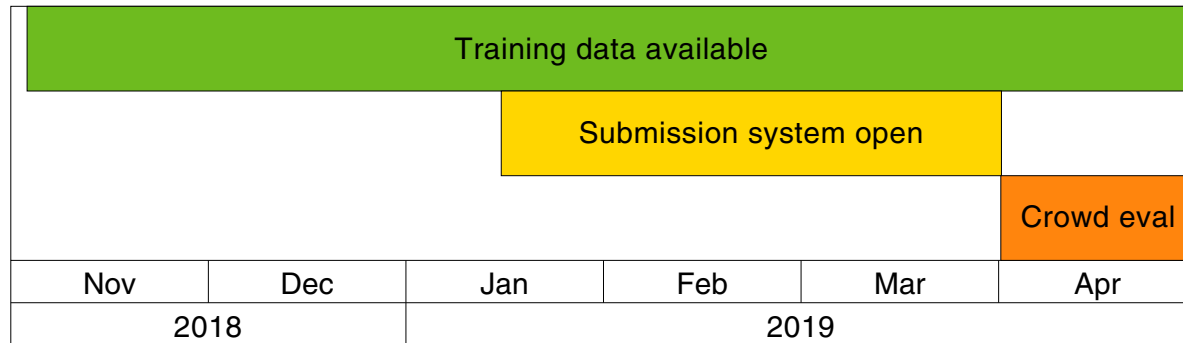

## Evaluation

- ❑ ROUGE for automatic evaluation (*content selection*)
- ❑ Crowdsourcing for qualitative evaluation

# Manual Evaluation

- ❑ Expensive, subjective yet highly crucial
- ❑ Likert scale, Best-to-worst scale
- ❑ Asking the right questions (DUC guidelines)

at the wmcj archives , i was able to locate dr morton jones ' thesis , a 20 - page document with " cholera infantum by verina m. harris , columbia , sc " written on the cover page ( figure 2 ) , 4 and a photo of her with 27 of her fellow students ( figure 3 ) . 5 morton jones attended wmcj for 4 years , though the school did not require this until 1893 . wmcj was an early adopter among american medical schools of the 4 - year graded curriculum .

# Dataset

## Mining **Reddit** for ground truths

1. Filter bots
2. Check if the post contains **tl.{0,3}dr**
3. Remove posts with multiple occurrences of **tl.{0,3}dr**
4. Preserve posts with any of the top 25 significant **tl.{0,3}dr** patterns
5. Remove posts where content is shorter than the summary (e.g. edits)
