1.	Graduate with clinical and scientific dental knowledge essential for general dental practice.
2.	Adequate scientific understanding to evaluate and assess various verified facts and data.
3.	A broad awareness of normal anatomy and function leads to an understanding of disease management, prevention, and therapy with medical and dental management.
4.	Adequate understanding of the development, structure, and function of teeth, mouth, jaws, and associated tissues in health and disease, as well as their link and effect on overall health and the patient's physical and social well-being.
5.	Adequate understanding of clinical disciplines and methodologies that provide a unified picture of abnormalities, lesions, and diseases of the teeth, mouth, and jaws.
6.	Adequate knowledge of dentistry's preventive, diagnostic, and therapeutic aspects.
7.	Adequate knowledge of biological function and behaviour of people in health and illness, as well as the influence of the natural and social environment on health in dentistry.
8.	Develop the skills to recognize physical and mental health, deal with emergencies, and engage with a variety of professional colleagues.
9.	Competent enough to carry out such procedures with grade skills in general practice.
