**Submission: September 15, 2024 EoE**

**Notification: approx. 4 weeks after the submission deadline**

As the submitted papers are reviewed within the standard IEEE ESL review system, we cannot offer a fixed notification date. However, ESL aims to notify authors of the review outcome within 4 weeks of the submission deadline.

## Submission Guidelines

### Length

Up to 4 pages in an IEEE double-column, single-blind, 10-pt format.

### Review process

The review is processed by IEEE Embedded Systems Letters (ESL).

### Publication

All accepted papers will be published in [IEEE ESL](#).

### Presentation

Authors of accepted papers will have the opportunity to present their work at SeHAS@HIPEAC 2025 in Barcelona, Spain. To present a paper at SeHAS, the presenting author must register for the HiPEAC conference (see registration details).
