To diagnose abnormal uterine bleeding, doctors ask women questions about the pattern of bleeding (menstrual history) and do a pelvic examination, ultrasonography, and blood tests. A biopsy of the lining of the uterus may be done. Treatment depends on the cause and may include hormones or other medications, such as a combination birth control pill, or a procedure, such as hysteroscopy and dilation and curettage (D and C) If the biopsy detects abnormal cells, treatment involves high doses of a progestin and sometimes removal of the uterus.
