Some tugging and pulling in my arm which came up really bruised but which was more uncomfortable than painful and a sensation when the die was released. But nothing too bad and I'd go through it again if I needed to.. and to be honest I'm a bit of a coward when it comes to medical treatment. They give a sedative and I wish I'd asked for more sooner. By the time I asked for more it was all over.

Believe me it is not painful...of course the usual insertion of the catater in the artery in your arm is similar to giving blood or having a blood test. I had four stents inserted..you get a strange sensation for 30 seconds when the stent is
