

Begin by removing the existing recoil pad from your stock using a phillps head screwdriver. Next using a long flat head screwdriver or the appropriate socket with extension remove the stock bolt from the inside of the opening in the rear of the stock as seen in Figure 1.



Next, insert the adapter tube into the rear of the pistol grip and align the pre-drilled hole on the top of the grip with the one in the tube as seen in Figure



Next, place the pistol grip with the adapter onto the rear of the shotgun. Place the 1/4"- 28 x 1 1/2" bolt and supplied washer through the back of the grip and adapter and using the appropriate allen wrench secure the pistol grip to the shotgun reciever as seen in Figure 2



Using the provided 8-32 x 3/4" Flat Head Socket Cap Screw and a 8/32 allen wrench, tighten the buffer tube to the pistol grip as seen in Figure 5.

Take the buffer tube and turn over and install the provided 8-32 square nut into the buffer top hole tube as seen in Figure 3.

NOTE: The screw in step 5 will tighten into this sqare nut.




To install the stock begin by pressing the adjustment lever as seen in Figure 6.

Next, grab the adjustment lever with your thumb and index finger and pull down as seen in Figure 7.



NOTE: DO NOT TRY TO PULL THE ADJUSTMENT LEVER FROM THE REAR AS SEEN IN FIGURE 8 AS THIS MAY CAUSE THE LEVER TO SNAP.



While holding the adjustment lever down as seen in Figure 2, slide the stock onto the buffer tube as seen in Figure 9 to complete your installation.
