Igor Makarov is an associate professor of finance at London School of Economics. His research covers theoretical and empirical topics in capital markets. Dr. Makarov has published in leading academic journals, including the Journal of Finance, the Journal of Financial Economics, and Review of Financial Studies. Dr. Makarov has won several professional awards, including the 2007 Crowell Memorial Prize (second place) for his work on sources of systematic risk and the 2012 NASDAQ OMX Award for his work on the CDS auctions.
