

## **General Instructions**

Pass-through entities may use TC-75, State and Local Tax (SALT) Report, to pay Utah income tax on behalf of individual members, partners and shareholders. Individuals for whom you pay this tax may claim a nonrefundable tax credit on their Utah Individual Income Tax Return.

## Reporting Requirements

In addition to filing this report, you must issue a Utah Schedule K-1 to each individual showing the amount of Utah tax paid on their behalf. Include all Schedules K-1 with your Utah tax return. See the instructions for the *Utah S Corporation Tax Return* (TC-20S) or the *Utah Partnership/LLP/LLC Return* (TC-65).

## **Due Date**

You must make payments on or before December 31 in order for them to count for the current tax year. Any payments made after the due date of a given year will be disallowed.

If you amend this report after December 31, only include payments made on or before that date. See *Prior Payments*, below.

## **Electronic Filing Requirement**

You must file this report and make payments electronically on Utah's Taxpayer Access Point (TAP, tap.utah.gov).

## Filing Instructions

## **Business and Preparer Information**

#### **Business Name**

Enter the pass-through entity's legal business name.

#### FEIN

Enter the pass-through entity's federal employer identification number.

#### **Organizational Structure**

Select the entity type from the drop-down list.

#### **Sub Entity Type**

Enter the sub entity type from the drop-down list, matching whichever is filed for federal tax purposes.

### Filing Period

From the drop-down, select the last day of the tax year for which you are making the payment.

#### Amended

Select "X" from the drop-down if this is an amended report.

#### **Address fields**

Enter the pass-through entity's mailing address.

#### Prepared By, Contact Phone # and Contact Email

Enter your name and contact information. We may contact you if there are any issues with processing this report.

## **Report Data**

Enter on a separate row each individual member, partner or shareholder for whom you are paying Utah income tax.

Column A Enter the individual's Social Security number.

Column B Enter the individual's first name.

Column C Enter the individual's last name.

Column D Select "X" from the drop-down list if the individual is a Utah resident or part-year resident.

Column E Enter the total state taxes paid to Utah and any other state(s) for this individual.

Column F Enter the Utah taxes you are paying for the individual.

## **Prior Payments**

If amending, use the "Prior Payments" tab to report any SALT payments made with previously-filed reports.

Column A Enter the day the payment was made (MM/DD/YYYY).

Column B Enter the TAP electronic payment confirmation number you received when you made the payment.

Column C Enter the payment amount.
