SCOPE OF WORK

BRIEF OVERVIEW

The proposed new iThemba LABS will house offices for 12 staff members, a meeting room, 5 laboratories for development work on electronics and detector systems, and ablution facilities, comprising an approximate floor area of 400 m².

ARCHITECTURAL

The look and feel of the new building will be mostly industrial/hi-tech architecture with subtle colours while providing tactile surfaces. The laboratories will have access flooring for cables as well as gas piping running underneath the equipment.

The wall finishes will be smooth, plastered walls with neutral colours while the door frames will be a dark and rich charcoal colour.

Ceilings will be a standard suspended ceiling system with shadow-line finishes on the periphery of the walls.

CURRENT STATUS

The Consulting Engineers is currently completing the tender document. We expect to advertise the bid before the end of the year and construction is expected to commence by March 2021. The construction period is 12 months.
