Capital Planning Advisory Team (CPAT) Overview

- ✓ Development of Capital Planning & Space Stewardship Policy currently in production and nearly published
- ✓ Creation of Capital Planning Guidelines
- ✓ To be fully implemented at next budget cycle (June 2023)

Why are the guidelines important?

- 1. Articulation of the 'how' behind our capital planning and space stewardship policy.
- 2. A transparent, annual process for submitting unit capital needs to assure that they are considered along with institutional needs and meet deadlines.
- 3. The ability to align projects with local and institutional needs and determine the most cost-effective solutions.

Who Should Follow the Guidelines?

What is in scope:

- Capital project needs greater than \$15M
- Any request for potential state funding
- Leases greater than 20 years or more than \$15M in total commitment

How are Capital Needs Submitted, Reviewed, and Prioritized?

- Annual Notice sent to campus leaders; informs the process and provides important timelines of the planning process
- Phase 1: Units/Departments submit an initial notice of capital needs to UW-Facilities
 - Project formation: Units work with Facilities' Account or Portfolio Managers to form each project application
- Phase 2: Capital project applications are submitted to CPAT
 - CPAT reviews and prioritizes each project
 - Please review the draft scoring methodology we constructed with CPAT in the guidelines draft
 - UW-F F&A reviews the Draft Capital Budget with campus partners
- Phase 3: CPAT makes recommendations to the President and Provost
