Conference Ethics and Quality Control

Conference Publication Procedure

We aim at publishing extended conference papers of high quality and value, providing the readers with original content meeting the best practices and requirements established worldwide by the international databases and publishing institutions. For that purpose we require the participants of the conference publishing process to follow the globally recognized Recommended Practices to Ensure Technical Conference Content Quality developed by ASCE, Elsevier, IEEE and The IET.

The following criteria shall be met by the Conferences:

- The Conference shall have a clear Call for Papers.
- The Papers submitted to the conference shall be in conformity with the conference scope.
- The Papers shall be presented in the English language of high quality.
- The Papers that are going to be published shall be presented at the conference at least by one of the Authors.
- Multiple submissions are not allowed the Paper shall be submitted to a single conference.
- The Paper shall be submitted by the corresponding Author on behalf of all co-authors.
- The Conference shall not use the predatory conference technics and shall follow the international spam ethics.
- The international conference shall ensure the geographical diversity of the participants.
- The Authors shall not contribute to more than 2 papers within one conference either as author or co-author.
- The Conference organizers shall not guarantee or promise any indexing for the conference on their website.

We provide the Conference organizers with the webinterface and online tools for managing the conference submission, peer-review and online publication.

The following control procedures are applied:

- All editorial process including the submission by Authors, peer-review, decision making by Editors and online publication shall be conducted via the Publisher's online tools.
- All papers should undergo a peer-review process involving independent scientists in the relevant field. The Conference organizers shall ensure that at least 2 Reviewers evaluate the paper and provide their reports.
- After the editorial work is finalized, every paper shall go through the similarity check powered by iThenticate. Plagiarism is considered unethical and is not acceptable.
- Before the online publication, the Publisher will conduct the internal review for additional evaluation of the papers to ensure the content meets the journal's and the international requirements. Based on the internal review results, nonconforming papers may be rejected from publication.
