Open Access Publishing

With open access publishing, the published articles will be available online to all readers who have internet access without financial, legal, or technical barriers (The Budapest Open Access Initiative, 2002).

ACTA Press supports Gold Open Access (gold OA) model. With gold OA, publications will be available to readers completely free of charge. Access is granted by a fee for publication that is paid at the time of article acceptance, usually by authors, the authors' institution, or funders. Articles become available immediately upon publication, and visitors to the ACTA Press website can immediately access, download, print, and read the full article. All ACTA Press articles are published under the Creative Commons Attribution License (CC-BY). Under Creative Commons Attribution License, author(s) retain copyright of their work, but readers have unrestricted use, distribution, and reproduction of an article in any medium, provided that the original work is properly cited.

Article Processing Charge

Like other Open Access publishers, ACTA Press charges an Article Processing Charge (APC) once an article is accepted for publication. This charge helps to cover the costs of the many stages involved in the publishing process, which includes:

- Initial Screening: Our editorial screening team will perform thorough initial technical and ethical checks prior to peer review.
- Peer Review: article is rigorously reviewed by the journal's academic Editorial Board comprising highly qualified researchers in a field appropriate for the article.
- Production processes: including professional typesetting process, proofing process, publishing process and indexing process.

The APC replaces subscription prices and allows ACTA Press to grant interested readers access to full-text open access publications. The actual amount payable as an APC varies depending on the journal in which you wish to publish your article. Prices are clearly displayed on our APC price list and on journal homepages.
