SAT or ACT (Optional): If you choose to apply Test Optional y may be invited to interview with an admission counselor.
Proof of English proficiency. Submit one of the following: TOEFL (79); IELTS (6.5); Duolingo (110); PTE (58)
English proficiency may be waived for students who have received a significant amount of academic instruction

International Student Application Supplement: This form will ask applicants to provide estimated financial support from family, sponsors, loans or government support.

SCHOLARSHIPS

ACADEMIC

\$15.000-\$32.500

Scholarships for first-year and transfer students are based on a review of academic records and are renewable each year of enrollment. No additional application is necessary.

GLOBAL SCHOLARS AWARD

Up to \$35,000 for first-year students, \$30,000 for transfer students

Scholarships available to incoming international students, renewable each year. Criteria is based on virtual interview and demonstration of committment to service and justice, leadership and global citizenship.

PRESIDENTIAL

\$25,000 to Full Tuition

Presidential scholarships recognize graduating high school seniors in the top tier of our applicant pool who embody the university's educational and leadership goals. Students must meet the early action application deadline and attend an in-person or virtual interview to be considered.

VISUAL AND PERFORMING ARTS (VAPA)

\$4,000 to \$30,000

Incoming first-year and transfer students with superior creative talent in Music, Theatre Arts, Multimedia or Visual Arts can apply. All applicants must submit an audition. For information, visit <u>CalLutheran.edu/VAPA</u>.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT GRANTS (NEED-BASED)

Incoming first-year and transfer students with demonstrated financial need are awarded annual grants. An additional application is required.
