

PhD Scholarship in machine learning and social network analytics

Applications are invited for two full-time PhD scholarships in machine learning and social network analytics, starting in January 2019 (or Fall 2019), in the College of Engineering and Computer Science at Florida Atlantic University. The PhD positions are fully funded by the National Science Foundation, and the students will also have opportunity to work closely with the industry to design algorithms and solutions for large scale data analytics and mining.

Successful applicants should

1. Have an undergraduate (honors) or master degree (preferred) in computer science or related field (preferably with good knowledge in mathematical modeling and statistics).
2. Be familiar with big data analytics tools and platforms.
3. possess solid programming skills in Java, C/C++, etc.

The due date for Spring admission is July 15 2018, and the due date for Fall admission is February 15 2019 (International Students).
