Subject: In respect of Ban on Sharp Manja in GNCT of Delhi – reg.

Inform you that kite flying is popular sport and it catches pace weeks before, during
festival of kite flying festivals of Makar Sankranti, Republic Day and Basant Panchmi, which are
observed on 14.01.2024, 26-01-2024 and 14.02.2024, respectively.

Kite flying by using thread made out of plastic, nylon or similar such synthetic
material including popularly known "Chinese thread/ manja" or any other thread coated with glass/
metallic particles causes a lot of injury to human beings and birds which many a times turns out
to be fatal. Such incidents have been seen in the news also during the last few years. Apart
from the flying threads being non-biodegradable also cause harm to the environment.

In order to prevent the adverse effects on human beings, cattle population, birds, soil
and environment, the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor of the National Capital Territory of Delhi, has
issued an order on 10.01.2017 with the following directions:-

- There shall be complete ban on the sale, production, storage, supply, import, and use of kite
flying thread made out of nylon, plastic or any other synthetic material including popularly
known "Chinese manja" and any other kite-flying thread that is sharp or made sharp such as
coated with glass, metal or any other sharp materials in the National Capital Territory of
Delhi.
- Kite flying shall be permissible only with a cotton thread, free from any sharp/ metallic/ glass
particles/ additives/ thread strengthening materials.

Violation of directions issued under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act,
1986 and any rule made thereunder shall be punishable under section 15 of the said Act which include
imprisonment for five years and / or with fine which may be extended to Rs. One Lac or with both.

The matter regarding ban on sharp manjha is being monitored by the various Hon'ble
Members of the Council of Ministers.

This information may be circulated amongst various divisions of your
Department for necessary action w.r.t. the following to generate awareness about the ban on
sharp manjha amongst the masses :
