

Muscle Cars

Cars are not just for driving. Some people like to collect cars, too. One type of car that people in the United States like to collect is called a muscle car. Muscle cars have large, powerful engines so that they can travel very fast, and many muscle cars are rare and very valuable. Because of this, collecting muscle cars (18).

Many muscle cars were built during the 1960s and the early 1970s, and a lot of collectors regard this period as the golden age of muscle cars. Although muscle cars are still being made today, the most popular ones were made over fifty years ago. People who collect such cars feel that they are (19) by owning them. When older people see such cars, they remember the fashions, the movies, the music, and the mood of the period in which these cars were made. Moreover, younger people can get a taste of it.

Another reason that people like owning muscle cars is that they like to play with the cars' engines. Unlike many modern cars, muscle cars have simple engine designs. Their owners can take apart the engines, repair and clean them, and then put them back together so that they will be even more powerful. Many collectors buy old, damaged muscle cars and spend their free time fixing them. Often, they must travel long distances to visit special shops to get the parts that they need. However, (20), they meet new people with similar interests in different parts of the country and learn more about their favorite kinds of cars.

Growing Corn

The United States is one of the world's largest producers of corn each year, with the majority grown in the nation's Midwest region. While the corn industry is an important part of the country's economy, it is also (21). The large number of corn plants make the region hotter. In an area that already has very high summer temperatures, climate change is making this a growing concern.

Interestingly, the crops do not actually change the temperature. When corn plants release water into the air—a process called corn sweat—the air becomes wetter. This added moisture makes the air more humid, which makes the temperature feel warmer. With so many corn crops in one area, thousands of liters of water are released from the plants every day. (22), local residents are feeling increasingly uncomfortable due to the higher humidity levels. In some cases, corn sweat can even make it dangerous for farmers to work outside for too long.

The situation seems to be getting worse because higher humidity is moving from rural to urban areas as the wind pushes the moist air into cities. In addition, corn crops (23). Corn releases more moisture than other plants, but most plants sweat to some degree. Soybeans also release a lot of moisture. Since corn and soybeans make up about 75 percent of the crops grown in the Midwest, any plans to increase production will only make uncomfortable weather conditions even worse.

The Arts and Crafts Movement

In the United Kingdom during the nineteenth century, new technology greatly changed how people lived. Until this time, many people lived on small farms. They worked with their family members and neighbors to make by hand what they needed to live. When new machines were invented and factories were built so that items could be produced more quickly and easily, people moved into cities to take jobs in the factories. They used the money they earned to buy the things they needed, many of which were made by machines instead of by hand.

Some people disliked these changes. In particular, one group of artists and designers believed that society would be better if people went back to the old ways of making things. They formed a group that became known as the Arts and Crafts movement to share their ideas and sell their products. Although some members produced paintings and sculptures, most made objects that could be used, such as books and fabrics that had been printed by hand, furniture, and dishes. They wanted to design beautiful, high-quality items that were useful in everyday life.

William Morris, a famous designer, was one of the most important members of the Arts and Crafts movement. He was not against the use of machines. However, he disagreed with the way that the managers of large factories produced items. These managers divided the process into small stages, with each worker only working on one stage. Morris thought workers would be happier and healthier if they were involved in the whole production process, worked in small shops, and met the people who bought and used their products.

For a while, the Arts and Crafts movement was a success. Public exhibitions were held to display and sell the products made by the members of the movement, and people in the United Kingdom and abroad were inspired to form similar organizations. During the twentieth century, however, the popularity of such products declined because they took too long to make and cost too much to buy. However, the ideas of the Arts and Crafts movement continue to influence the way that artists and designers think about their work.
