

- Students must complete a minimum of 120-degree credits for graduation.
- Required for the BFA in Theater: **121 Credits**; 106 Scenic Design Program credits plus an additional 15 Liberal Arts credits.
- 33 Liberal Arts credits are required for graduation. Theater courses also fulfilling Liberal Arts requirements are noted with a single asterisk (*).
- Minimum GPA requirement: 2.0. Students must earn a C grade or better in the required Theater courses or repeat the course.
- This is a four-year program; students must be registered for a minimum of 12 credits each semester to achieve full-time status.

PRODUCTION & DESIGN PROJECTS 07:966:422

Students may be assigned a production assignment in any semester, beginning in the second year. These assignments are not guaranteed and will be assigned to students who are in good academic/artistic standing, and as their advisor deems appropriate. Credits will be determined by the advisor based on the size/scope of the project, and the student's role.
