<u>Nigerian Communications Commission (NCC) directs network operators to suspend the sale of new SIM cards</u>

In accordance with the announcement from the Nigerian Communications Commission (NCC), directing the nationwide suspension of new SIM card sales and activations, and initiating a Subscriber Registration Database audit, MTN Nigeria has suspended the sale, registration and activation of new SIM cards across all touchpoints. This includes MTN Service Centres, Connect Stores and all affiliated Retail/Trade Outlets.

We regret the inconvenience this will cause some of our customers and are committed to working with the NCC to complete the planned audit in an efficient and seamless manner.

Existing MTN customers can continue to access all other services such as airtime and data purchases, and live support via MyMTN App and our online channels or they can walk into any of our stores for assistance. In addition, customers can visit our Service Centres in Asaba, Ibadan, Kaduna and Port Harcourt to secure Digital Identification from the National Identity Management Commission Agents stationed there.

MTN Nigeria remains committed to supporting the Government's efforts to create a secure and sustainable digital economy and are steadfast in our relentless drive to assure compliance with SIM registration regulations. We will join other industry stakeholders in a meeting with Dr. Isa Ali Pantami, the Honourable Minister of Communications and Digital Economy, to chart a course of action.
