Counter measures are **necessary** to protect the individual and thus society

Think about the data you store!

- Not storing is best
- Second choice: digital stealth mode
 - Example: video camera why store complete pictures of every person rather than the action?
- How to build tamper proof devices that respect stealth mode?
- Integration into legislation?
- New ethics for data centres!
