

## PROGRAM COST ESTIMATE- BSN & Entry-Level MSN Pre-Licensure only

## **ABOUT THIS ESTIMATE**

To assist students with financial planning, the School of Nursing has compiled a list of common expenses specific to nursing coursework. Most pre-licensure programs charge similar fees. This is an estimate only and these costs are subject to change without notice. It does not include tuition, housing, meal plans, or other items ordinarily billed. Health insurance is required of all nursing students; individual premiums vary (PLU Wellness Access Plan is not sufficient to meet health insurance requirement).

| Health Requirement Tracker (CastleBranch)   | \$117                          | One-time                       |
| Background check  | \$21                           | Yearly                         |
| CPR certification   | \$60 (estimate)                | Yearly                         |
| Health Insurance  | Varies                         | Ongoing                        |
| Vaccines/flu shot/Hepatitis Titers  | Varies, depending on insurance | Renewal dates vary             |
| Uniforms  | \$50-80 per set                | One-time                       |
| Shoes   | \$50 (varies by preference)    | One-time                       |
| Laptop  | \$1000 (varies by preference)  | One-time                       |
| Transportation – (Students must provide their own transportation to assigned clinical sites)        | \$300 (varies per student)     | Per semester                   |
| Textbooks   | \$800-\$1200                   | Per Semester                   |
| Stethoscope (optional)  | \$50-150                       | One-time                       |
