Excellency,

Further to my letter of 26 June 2024 and recalling General Assembly resolution 76/307 entitled “Modalities for the Summit of the Future” and Decision 77/568 entitled “Scope of the Summit of the Future”, I have the honour to circulate the provisional programme for the Summit of the Future which will be held under the theme “*Summit of the Future: Multilateral solutions for a better tomorrow*” from 22 to 23 September 2024 at the United Nations Headquarters in New York.

Following the meeting of the General Committee held on 24 June 2024, and subsequently, the Ambassadorial-level meeting convened by the co-facilitators on 27 June 2024 where delegations had the opportunity to share their feedback on the topics and organization of the interactive dialogues of the Summit, as well as follow-up discussions with the co-facilitators, I have the further honour to share the following revised topics for the interactive dialogues, for your consideration:

- Interactive Dialogue 1: Transforming global governance and turbocharging the implementation of the 2030 agenda for sustainable development.
- Interactive Dialogue 2: Enhancing multilateralism for international peace and security.
- Interactive Dialogue 3: Towards a Common Digital Future: strengthening inclusive innovation and cooperation to bridge the digital divides.
- Interactive Dialogue 4: The Future Starts Now: enhancing the global system for current and future generations.

Further details pertaining to inscriptions for the interactive dialogues as well as the respective concept notes will be shared shortly.

I wish to sincerely thank the co-facilitators, the Permanent Representatives of Namibia and Germany, for their hard work in steering the intergovernmental preparatory process thus far and I once again urge delegations to continue their constructive engagement towards the finalization of an outcome document that represents our collective ambition.
