
SELECTED RESERVE ARMY **RESERVE** INCENTIVE PROGRAM

SELECTED RETENTION BONUS (SRB)

Up to **\$10K** available to critical MOSs in priority units, plus **\$30K** SLRP if eligible



PRIORITY UNIT BONUS \$5K available to all MOSs, can be combined with cash bonus; UIC coded in REQUEST.

OPTIONS

WILL TRAIN Soldiers have the option to transfer to a critical MOS for additional incentives once trained. Review the In-Out Call list for eligibility. You must be E-6 and below with less than 17 years of service.

POST 9/11 GI BILL **TRANSFER OF EDUCATION BENEFITS (TEB) PROGRAM**

Allows Soldiers to transfer the unused portion of their Post 9/11 GI Bill to their eligible dependent(s) in exchange for a one-time, four-year Additional Duty Service Obligation (ADSO) to the Army.
