SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority #20-04: Final Action of U.S. Army Reserve Troop Program Unit Officer Involuntary Separations and Related Actions

## 1. References.

- a. Memorandum, U.S. Army Reserve Command, AFRC-PRP, 19 Mar 18, Subject: Delegation of Authority to Take Final Action of U.S. Army Reserve (USAR) Troop Program Unit (TPU) Officer Involuntary Separations and Related Actions.
  - b. Army Regulation (AR) 135-175, Separation of Officers, 20 March 2020.
- 2. This memorandum supersedes reference 1a and remains in effect until superseded, rescinded, or withdrawn.
- 3. In accordance with AR 135-175, para 2-9c, I delegate authority to the U.S. Army Reserve Command (USARC) Deputy Commanding General to take final action (approval or disapproval) on the recommendations of boards of officers, recommendations for separation without board action for officers with less than five years of commissioned service, and resignations in lieu of involuntary separation, based on the reasons in AR 135-175, Chapter 2, Section II. This delegation of authority applies to USAR TPU officers under the jurisdiction of the USARC.
