SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority #20-36A: Amendment – Voluntary Branch Transfers, Functional Area (FA) Designation Requests, and Awarding/Withdrawing Additional Skill Identifiers (ASIs) and Special Qualification Identifiers (SQIs) for U.S. Army Reserve Troop Program Unit Officers

1. References.

United States Army Reserve Command (USARC), AFRC-CG memorandum (Delegation of Authority #20-36: Voluntary Branch Transfers, Functional Area (FA) Designation Requests, and Awarding/Withdrawing Additional Skill Identifiers (ASIs) and Special Qualification Identifiers (SQIs) for U.S. Army Reserve Troop Program Unit Officers), 30 Dec 20.
- b. Office of the Chief of Staff, G-1, DAPE-ZA memorandum (Exception to Army Regulation (AR) 140-10, Army Reserve Assignment, Attachments, Details, and Transfers), 2 Mar 22.
- 2. This memorandum amends reference 1a, as authorized by reference 1b, by delegating authority to the USARC Major Subordinate Commands (MSCs) with general officer commanders with legal support to approve requests for voluntary branch transfer, FA designation, and award ASIs or SQIs, and Areas of Concentrations (AOCs), in accordance with reference 1b and current proponent guidance. This delegation excludes the classification of warrant officers of the Judge Advocate General's Corps (JAGC). MSCs replace Readiness Divisions (RDs) as approval authorities.
- 3. This authority only applies to USAR TPU officers under the administrative control of this Headquarters and rests solely at the MSC-level. Upon validation and approval, MSCs will forward actions to RDs for issuance of appropriate orders/documentation. This authority only applies to branch transfers that do not require new appointments (Chaplain, Army Medical Department (U.S. Army) branches, Cyber, and JAGC).
- 4. The remainder of reference 1a remains in effect except for approval authority for Functional Area 57, Simulations Operations, which now rests with the 84th Training Command rather than the 75th Innovation Command.
- 5. This delegation is effective immediately and will remain in effect until superseded, rescinded, or withdrawn.

- 2. This memorandum supersedes references 1a and 1b, and remains in effect until superseded, rescinded, or withdrawn.

SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority #20-36: Voluntary Branch Transfers, Functional Area (FA) Designation Requests, and Awarding/Withdrawing Additional Skill Identifiers (ASIs) and Special Qualification Identifiers (SQIs) for U.S. Army Reserve Troop Program Unit Officers

- 3. I delegate authority to the Readiness Division (RD) Commanders to approve requests for voluntary branch transfer, FA designation, and award ASIs or SQIs in accordance with this policy/enclosures and current proponent guidance, except the classification of warrant officers of the Judge Advocate General's Corps (JAGC).
- 4. This authority only applies to USAR TPU officers under the administrative control of this Headquarters and rests solely at the RD level. Major Subordinate Commands (MSCs) will validate requirements and provide endorsements to the RDs. In addition, RDs have the authority to award Areas of Concentration (AOC) as required. This authority applies only to branch transfers that do not require new appointments (Chaplain, Army Medical Department (U.S. Army) branches, Cyber, and JAGC).
- 5. Officers and warrant officers must meet the requirements contained in references 1d and 1g. When processing branch transfers, both the losing and gaining proponents must concur prior to the transfer to a new AOC or FA.
- 6. Subordinate commands will submit all voluntary branch transfers, FA redesignation requests, and requests to award or withdraw ASIs/SQIs for TPU officers and warrant officers to the MSCs according to the USAR PAG. MSCs will validate Soldiers meet requirements and forward requests to the supporting RD for approval. RDs will provide justification when returning disapproved requests. For AMEDD requests, MSCs will utilize the specific formats located in the USAR PAG and submit packets to Human Resources Command, Health Services Division at usarmy.knox. hrc.mbx.rpmd-hsd-career-mgt-br@mail.mil. For JAGC requests, MSCs will coordinate with and forward request packets to the Office of the Judge Advocate General at usarmy.pentagon.hqda-otjag.mbx.reserve-component@mail.mil.
