SUBJECT: Army Reserve Soldiers Who Deploy as Civilian Employees

1. References:

e. ASA/MRA, SAMR-TRM, memorandum, (Training of Reserve Component Units and Individuals in Areas Designated for Receipt of Hostile Fire / Imminent Danger Pay and Combat Zones, 14 Feb 06.

2. This memorandum supersedes reference 1a.

3. The Army Reserve continues to have a large number of Soldiers employed overseas by civilian companies. Retaining Soldiers is the number one priority of the Army Reserve. The following guidance will allow Army Reserve Soldiers to remain in the Selected Reserve and participate in training activities while employed overseas to include Soldiers employed as contractors for civilian companies.

4. Commanders have the following options:

a. First priority, retain Soldiers deployed as civilian employees for less than one year in their unit of assignment. Commanders will authorize those affected Soldiers the opportunity to perform duty closer to their areas of employment but outside an imminent danger area or hostile Fire zone as indicated below. See the list of Army Reserve Units and prohibited inactive duty locations in enclosure 1.

DAAR-HR

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(1) Attachment of Soldiers to the closest Army Reserve unit to their areas of employment to perform Annual Training. Coordinating attachment through his/her chain of command is the Soldier's responsibility.

(2) To perform inactive duty training (IDT) with the closest Army Reserve units to their areas of employment. Inactive duty training will be at no travel or per diem costs to the government. IDT will be coordinated with the Soldier's chain of command and require a request to rescheduled training, a training plan, and submission of a DA Form 1380, Record of Individual Performance of Reserve Duty Training, upon completion of his/her duty.

b. In accordance with reference 1b, reassign Soldier to the Standby Reserve Active Status List.

c. Soldiers that have accepted an overseas employment opportunity and have completed their Military Service obligation may consider transferring to the Individual Ready Reserves (IRR).

5. Because of the potential costs to the Soldier, retention in the Selected Reserve while temporarily residing overseas for less than one year must be on a voluntary basis. Eligible Soldiers will be counseled by their first line leaders using the DA Form 4856, Developmental Counseling Form in enclosure 2, to ensure they understand travel to and from an overseas location to perform duty or report for mobilization will not incur any costs to the government except for pay and allowances. Those non-obligated Soldiers notifying their commands of overseas residency exceeding one year will be reassigned to the Standby Reserve for a period not to exceed 30 months in accordance with reference 1b.

6. See enclosure 3 for processing procedures for all Army Reserve Soldiers that deploy as civilians.

7. This memorandum remains in effect until rescinded or superseded.

Processing Procedures and Options for Army Reserve Soldiers Deployed or Employed in a Civilian Duty Status Overseas

If: An Army Reserve Soldier elects to remain a member of the Army Reserve Troop Program Unit (TPU) while overseas in a civilian capacity for 12 months or less.

Then: Recommended action: Soldier deployed in a foreign country coordinates with an overseas Army Reserve unit in order to perform Inactive Duty Training (IDT) and Annual Training (AT) requirements. The Soldier's assigned unit will assist with the coordination to set up the Soldier for success.

1. Required Documents:

- a. DA 1380 (Army Reserve Record of Individual Performance) signed by an officer having knowledge of duty performed.
- b. Annual Training orders, if the Soldier performs Annual Training.

2. Processing instructions:

a. Army Reserve overseas unit. The overseas Army Reserve unit will complete a DA 1380 for all IDT performed and send it to the Soldiers assigned unit for pay processing. The overseas Army Reserve unit will sign the Soldier's annual training orders and send it to the Soldiers assigned unit for pay processing.

b. Soldier's assigned unit. The Soldier's assigned unit will process all pay received within three days and notify the Soldier once complete.

Note: All travel expenses are the responsibility of the Soldier.

Note: If the Soldier does not perform at least 35 MUTAs, they will not earn a good year for retirement and could become a non-participant.

Note: If the Soldier does not drill regularly, they will accrue an SGLV debt. It is recommended Soldiers cancel their SGLV prior to deploying overseas in a civilian status.

If: An Army Reserve Soldier is overseas in a civilian capacity for more than 12 months or more (up to 30 months) with a remaining Military Service Obligation.

Then: Recommended action. The Soldier should transfer to the Standby Active List.

Note: Soldiers assigned to the Standby Active List may perform Inactive Duty Training for Points only as long as they are attached to a unit and authorized by the unit commander.

If: An Army Reserve Soldier will be overseas in a civilian capacity for more than 12 months and has completed their Military Service Obligation.

Then: Recommended action: The Soldier should transfer to the Individual Ready Reserve.

Note one: Soldiers who have not fulfilled their Military Service obligation officers consider option one or two IOT avoid a bonus debt.

Note two: Soldiers may perform Inactive Duty for training for points only as long as they are attached to a unit and authorized by the Army Human Resources Command.

Reassignment of Army Reserve Troop Program Unit (TPU) Soldiers to the Individual Ready Reserve (IRR): Definitions

1. **Statutory Military Service Obligation (SMSO)** - The statutory MSO is incurred on initial entry to the Armed Forces whether by induction, enlistment, or appointment. On or after 1 June 1984, all Soldiers incur an 8-year statutory MSO. A contractual obligation is acquired when an individual voluntarily enters into an agreement to serve in a military status for a specific period. See AR 135-91, chapter 2.
2. **TPU Contractual Obligation Service (TCOS) date** - The date at which a first-term Soldier completes their contractual obligation to satisfactorily participate in a TPU. The most common TPU contractual obligation is 6 of 8 years (6x2); however, Soldiers may be on a 4x4 or 3x5 contract, etc.
3. **Expiration Term of Service (ETS)** - The scheduled date on which a Soldier's statutory or contractual (whichever is later) term of military service will end. A First Term Soldier's ETS date is their SMSO date.
4. **Ready Reserve (RR) obligation**- Part of the statutory and/or contractual obligation, in which a Soldier is required to satisfactorily participate in a TPU or RR Control Group. Includes the SELRES and IRR Control Groups.
5. **Standby Ready Reserve**- consists of Soldiers who maintain their military affiliation without being in the Ready or Retired Reserve. Membership is limited to those Soldiers having mobilization potential. Soldiers with a statutory MSO, temporarily placed in the Standby Reserve, will be transferred back to the Ready Reserve at the earliest possible date. Voluntary members of the Standby Reserve, unable to transfer to the Ready Reserve and possessing critical skills determined by the SECARMY to be mobilization assets, may be retained instead of discharged. Soldiers on the Active Status List may participate in Reserve training activities at no expense to the government, earn retirement points, and be eligible for promotion. The Active Status List consists of Soldiers assigned under the following conditions (AR 140-10, 8-2):
 - Key Employees; Reserve Officers with a remaining Service obligation at the time of removal from Ready Reserve may be transferred only to the Standby Reserve Active Status List (AR 135-133, 2-11(b)(1))
 - Temporary hardship (extreme personal or community hardship)
 - Temporary medical disqualification
 - Theological Students
 - Overseas residency or missionary obligations (will not exceed 30 months)
 - Confirmed as infected with the Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV)
 - Secretarial determination

Reassignment of Army Reserve Troop Program Unit (TPU) Soldiers to the Individual Ready Reserve (IRR): Definitions

6. Individual Ready Reserve (IRR)- the IRR consists of pre-trained individual Soldiers assigned to various control groups for control and administration who are available for mobilization in time of war or a national emergency declared by Congress. Soldiers in the Individual Ready Reserves are considered mobilization assets, but are not required to perform Inactive Duty for Training (IDT). Soldiers in an IRR status may request authorization to perform IDT while assigned to the IRR from the Army Human Resources Command (HRC).

7. Selected Reserve (SELRES) - This allows Soldiers who enlisted in the Selected Reserve, have a remaining statutory military service obligation, and have incurred either a bona fide temporary, nonmilitary obligation requiring overseas residency outside the United States, or a bona fide temporary (not to exceed 30 months), religious missionary obligation. Additionally, reference 1c states that a Soldier with a remaining service obligation may be reassigned/transferred to the Standby Reserve to temporarily reside overseas or to fulfill a temporary nonmilitary employment obligation requiring overseas residency, or bona fide, temporary missionary obligation.

8. IRR Control Groups - Control Group (Annual training), Control Group (Reinforcement), Control Group (Officer Active Duty Obligor), and Control Group (Dual Component).

9. First-Term Soldier - Soldier who is on their initial contract with remaining SMSO.

10. Career Soldier - Soldiers who have completed their SMSO and reenlisted for continued service.

11. Mobilization Asset - Soldiers that are currently available to their reporting units for deployment/employment to accomplish/provide their core functions or designed capabilities.
