Alexander Dietmüller and Janine Thoma agrees to facilitate the distribution.

*Career Events / Personal Development* VMITET has budget to support the organization of workshops, talks, or other activities. As long as it benefits a large part of the Mittelbau at D-ITET, anything is potentially possible.

*Comments* 1500 Fr. are budgeted for D+ITET for the organization of events.  
These events should target a large audience to be eligible for funding.

*Vote* 0 against, 0 abstentions, 12 in favour (1 person left before the vote).

## 8. Miscellaneous

Strategies to attract more members are discussed (only 50% of potential members are actual members of VMITET). There is already a “Join Us” button on the website. Having posters or flyers at the monthly apéros to encourage people to join VMITET; and also to explain that VMITET and AVETH are linked.
